Mushiba: Lesson Learning can be tricky because while we must learn lessons by going within Self, we also must learn by going outside of Self. Thus, it is our challenge to find the balance between determining what we need to learn through another person and being concerned about what that person is here to learn $\tilde{}$ and, which may not be related at all to our own learning.

During his class, Cycle of Lesson Learning, Waith said:

Waith: "It is of no concern to any of you what another is here to learn ~ only what you are here to learn is of importance."

Waith's words remind us of that fine line we each walk \sim being concerned about our own learning while thinking how it relates to the learning of another person. We can become so caught up in wondering what another is here to learn that we neglect reflecting on our own *Lesson Learning*.
