Self is Like a Little Ball of Yeast Dough



Mushiba: Waith loves to use analogies to explain Universal Concepts ~ and, has come up with some pretty cute ones through the years. During an early Waith Public Session, he was discussing the concept that energy splits ~ and splits and splits... ~ at the moment it comes out of The One and becomes Individual. In his attempt to simplify the concept, he explained it this way:

Waith: "Think of Self as a piece of yeast dough for bread ~ a little ball ~ and if you keep the ball as it is, it will expand ~ and will grow bigger and bigger. If you take that piece of dough and divide it, it does not harm the dough, and each piece then becomes its own little piece and it grows.

"You can cut that dough again and again and again ~ it is still a part of the whole. It has come from the whole and at any point can be brought back into the whole, so that the ball becomes One again, for it is all from the same ingredients. So too, is energy able to be split. Think of Self as a little flashing ball of Light, of brightness that can split and then form into a particular manifestation.

"The difference, of course, between you and a piece of dough is that when your energy splits, the thread that connects you to The One is not severed it is simply spread out so that there is never the danger of the energy being severed from its main source. And, it is this that enables an energy to take on different manifestations."
