Failure? Not According To The Universe



Mushiba: *Failure*. That one word is loaded with emotion because most people have been told at one time or another, that they were a failure $\tilde{}$ or that something they did was a failure. Ugh! There is another way to view this and spin the word *failure* from being a negative to being a positive:

Waith: "There is no such thing as failure. We emphasize this. It is in this concept that you have of failure that creates so much of the problem. It simply means that the test that you undertook was not passed ~ it does not mean you failed. It simply means that it is necessary to have another test ~ you were not ready.

"The Soul will bring continual tests and force itself to have test after test after test. Some Souls will require and want more testing because it wants a particular level of strength that is different from another Soul. None of you fail. In the scheme of The Universe, there is no failure. Even those of the highest darkness are not considered to have failed ~ they simply are further away from the Light than another energy. They, too, have their lessons that their Soul has taken on."

When I am faced with a test, I try to select the *optimum* solution. If my solution does not work, I view it as *less than optimum*, rather than as a failure.
