## Saving or Serving Others?



**Mushiba:** When do we help another? When do we not? The answer can only come from Self. We are here to learn lessons and to serve (help) others "when they ask us" in their lesson learning. We are not expected to save the world, and we are not expected to Save Others "only to Serve Others whom The Universe sends.

Saving Or Serving Others ~ how do we know the difference? Waith counsels us:

Waith: "There are situations set up on the earth plane for entities to learn lessons. For example, an entity who is abused is in that situation for specific lessons they have chosen to learn. Those who might want to serve, or help, have taken that opportunity, for Self, for lesson learning.

"There can be a tendency with some who think all that happens has been taken on by the Soul, and thus, may not be sympathetic to the abuse because they feel they do not need to be. This is far from the truth. Each of you is responsible to the other. What matters is what you choose to take on as your responsibility for lessons to be learned and lessons to be taught. For example, you may be involved in helping an entity who has been abused while having no interest in helping an alcoholic. This is fine because there are others who have taken on the issue of helping an alcoholic.

"Do not feel you must help the entire earth plane ~ it simply is not meant to be. Many people might feel inadequate because they think they should be devoting their entire lives to all the causes. Remember that The Universe is in control ~ proportionately. Those situations that have been set up for learning will each have their proportion of those who will be serving those who are learning. Thus, those who are serving are learning and teaching ~ and, teaching and learning. You grow in your strength as you serve and carry this into other incarnations ~ and it provides in you the strength to develop from lifetime to lifetime."

When I think of *Saving or Serving* Others, I remember a phrase I heard years ago: "Save us from those who would want to save us." To me, Saving means imposing and Serving means helping. If someone is helping me, I am open to receiving, while if someone is imposing on me, I am closed. So, how do I know when to Serve (and be served) and when not to Serve? Only I can answer that for Self ~ and that comes by gaining experience by living my life.
