Being Successful



Mushiba: *Being Successful*, I believe, is both concrete and abstract ~ and depending on who we ask, success is how much money, the kind of job and how many possessions a person has ~ or, it is a state of mind that is supported by a strong sense of Self. I view *Being Successful* as a balance between concrete and abstract ~ a balance as determined by Self for Self and fluid in its application. Here is an example of what Waith says about *Being Successful*:

Question: "When I finish this degree I'm working on, will I be successful in finding a full-time position?"

Waith: "Each entity can do what they so choose to do ~ not a new idea. However, the difference between those entities who are successful and

those who are not, is in recognizing opportunities as opportunities ~ for opportunities are presented to everyone every day ~ and seeing them as something that can be seized.

"It becomes easier to recognize your opportunities as you become more in tune with your Higher Self, as you become aware of The Oneness ~ that is in you ~ with The Universe. Opportunities are often disguised and why people do not see them for what they are ~ they are looking for specific things.

"The Universe sends you opportunities packaged differently from what you might expect. It is why being in touch with the Higher Self is so critical because it opens up your awarenesses and helps you to see beyond the senses to which you are accustomed ~ and it helps you to see situations differently."

We are living in a time of changing illusions and are bombarded with opportunities from The Universe, most of which are packaged differently from our usual frame of reference. Thus, we are reevaluating what *Being Successful* means ~ are we adapting to the changes ~ are we helping others to adapt?

I believe that part of our lesson learning is to trust in The Universe that we are receiving what we *need* and not necessarily what we *want* perhaps one of our greatest lessons to learn. And while we ponder Self's role as the illusions change, remember to *Focus on Lightheartedness and the Spreading of Light!*
