Feeling Frustrated Is A Sign Of Growth

During a public session, Waith was asked why a feeling of frustration happens during lesson learning:

Question: "So, I should learn to live with it?"

There is not so much an accepting of the frustration as there is an understanding that it will always be there. "If you look back through your growth stages and what you were feeling and the type of frustration that you had, you might say, 'Oh, why was I so frustrated ~ I have a better understanding now of what that was all about and there's no reason to have been frustrated ~ that was easy.' This occurs as you overcome challenges and hurdles."

Question: "More hurdles to come?"

Waith: "Indeed. There will always be ~ and that is growth. If you do not feel frustrated, then there is no growth occurring."

Can you imagine that an Angelic also has feelings of frustration? I can \tilde{I} only need to reflect on all the things \tilde{I} just in *this* life.
