The Game of Lesson Learning



Mushiba: In Waith's phases of *Cycle of Lesson Learning*. he elaborated on this Cycle by using the analogy that a lesson is simply a Game:

Waith: "In this Game there are six components ~ Identify the Game, Learn the Rules, Play by the Rules, Do not Play by the Rules, Change the Rules, and Create New Rules, which essentially then becomes a New Game."

According to Waith, here is his Comparison Between the Cycle of Lesson Learning and The Game:

"Phase One: Learning a Lesson without help.

The Game: Identify The Game; Learn the rules.

Phase Two: Learning the same lesson with help from others.

The Game: Play by the rules; Do not play by the rules.

Phase Three: Helping another to learn that lesson that you have been learning.

The Game: Change the rules.

Phase Four: Helping one to help one who is helping another to learn that lesson you have been learning.

The Game: Create a new version of the rules ~ thus, a New Game."
